### Annual membership fees

- ▶ 72€ for ordinary personal members
- ▶ 28€ for job starters for a four year period
- ▶ 12€ for junior members (students)
- ▶ 25 percent reduction in membership fees for multiple membership

Membership of the first technical society is free of charge. For the second membership 10€ is added to the membership fee. For each further membership 20€.

Membership of the technical societies is free of charge to junior members.

**Ordinary membership** is available to persons who can provide evidence of training in engineering or another scientific discipline or who have long working experience in electrotechnology or related fields.

**Junior membership** is available to students at universities or similar centres of education. At the end of the year in which they complete their studies, they become ordinary members (job starters).

**Note:** The VDE publishing house will contact new members and inform them about reduced subscription rates offered to VDE members for technical periodicals and books from the publishing house.

**Junior members** receive direct from the publishing house a single voucher which entitles them to a year's free subscription to one of the publishing house's technical periodicals – etz or ntz.
